### **In this e-news:      New RVAHJ Website Rollout**

We have been working hard over the course of 2017 to develop a new website for members with a range of additional features and information with easier navigation. As a result, a new platform and latest software has been used for our RVAHJ website.

During the development process, some Justices received a notification about change of email addresses; this was a result of setting up the new membership database on the site for a number of features including the 'Find a Justice Of The Peace' feature. No action is needed to be taken on these by any member who received the notification.

The target is to roll the new website out over the next few weeks as we complete testing. On the roll out and going live of the new website, all members will receive an email asking them to login to the new (membership) site and create your own unique / new password, as we are not able to transfer existing passwords from the old system. All members will be able to review and update their information accordingly at the same time.

Over the last year, several notices have gone out informing members that the jp or bj email addresses hosted by the association will no longer be available and we strongly recommend to those who are still using this as their primary email address, to take this opportunity to update their email to gmail, yahoo, Hotmail, etc. which are freely available and more transportable.

With the new website, we have introduced a RVAHJ store which will be progressively updated after the go live initial roll out to include all the merchandise currently available from the association, as well as a new feature of payment of membership fees online.

We also ask for your patience and understanding in that, with any change(s) there is always some fine tuning that is required, even after the extensive testing that we have done.

This is a major initiative which will provide additional features and benefits both now and into the future for all members.
